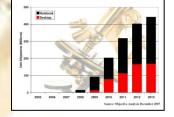

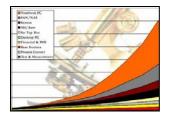

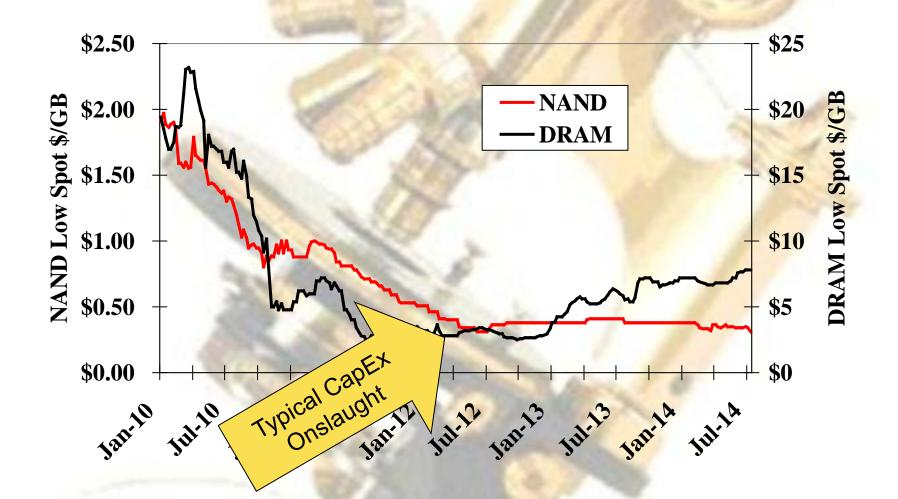


Now Entering a Time of Change

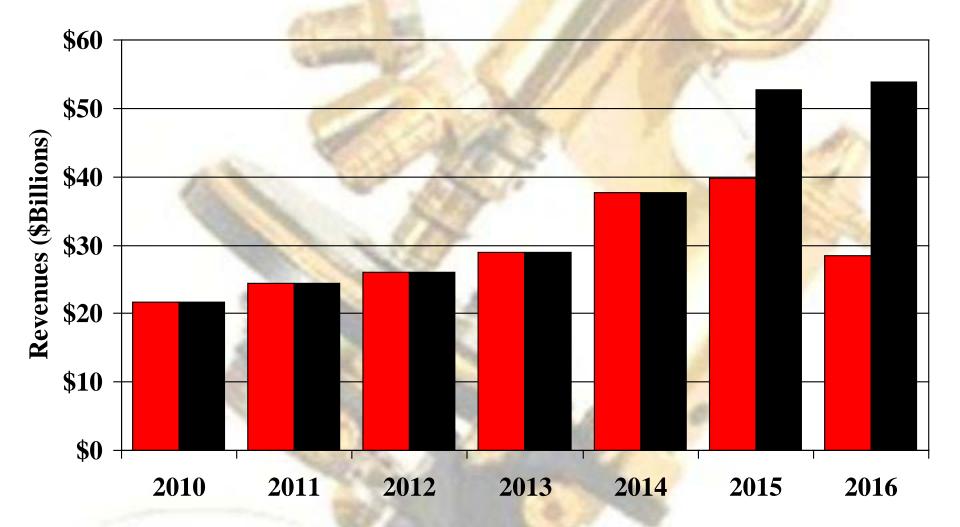
- Historical behaviors no longer followed
 - Typical memory "Boom/Bust" cycle is investment driven
 - Profits aren't driving CapEx as they always have in the past
- Major technology shifts underway
 - NAND: Planar \rightarrow Hi-k \rightarrow 3D
 - SSDs: SLC \rightarrow MLC \rightarrow TLC \rightarrow 3D
 - Systems: HDD \rightarrow SSD \rightarrow PCIe \rightarrow M/B Flash

Enterprise SSD Forecast

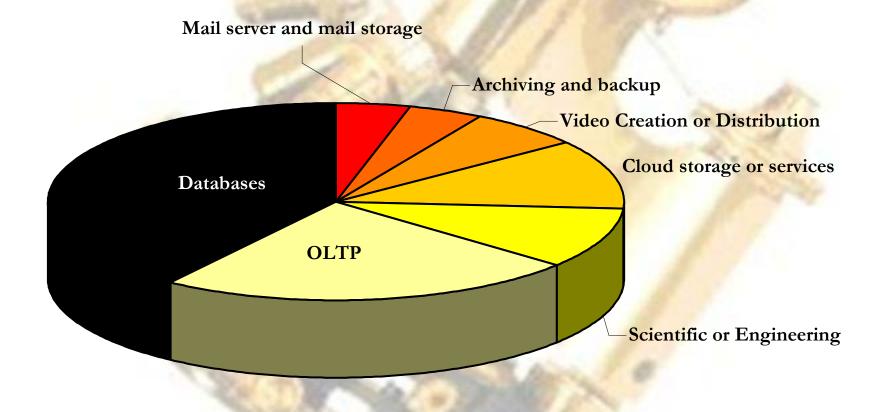

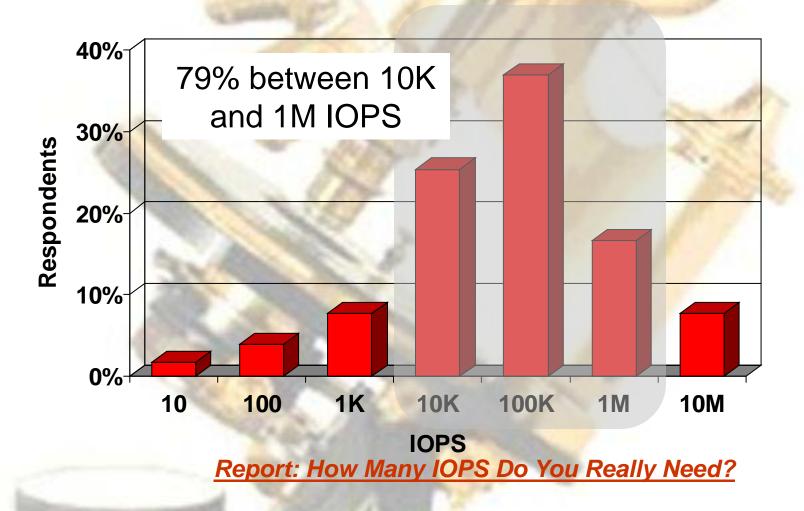
